

RESOLUTION NO. 54-23

RESOLUTION SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING DATE TO AMEND ZONING  
ORDINANCE TO ADJUST THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE  
PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Delaware County implemented zoning regulations within their jurisdiction;  
and,

WHEREAS, the number of the board members needs to remove Delaware County board  
members from the Planning and Zoning Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the Dyersville Planning and Zoning Commission held an open meeting to  
the public, and voted to approve the revised Planning and Zoning Commission membership; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dyersville will consider the amendment to  
the zoning ordinance; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
DYERSVILLE, IOWA:

Section 1. This Council shall meet on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August 2023, at 6:00 PM, at the  
Memorial Building, 340 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue East, in the City, at which time and place proceedings will be  
instituted and action taken to approve or deny the zoning amendment.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of the proposed action, the  
time and place where said meeting will be held, by publication at least seven days before said  
meeting in a legal newspaper of general circulation in the City. Said notice shall be in substantially  
the following form:

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City Council of the City of Dyersville, Iowa, will meet at the Memorial Building, 340  
1<sup>st</sup> Avenue East, on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August 2023, at 6:00 PM, at which time and place proceedings  
will be instituted and action taken to approve or deny the zoning amendment to adjust the number  
of members of the Planning and Zoning Commission.

At the meeting, the Council will receive oral or written objections from any resident or  
property owner of the City. The Council may take additional action to approve the zoning  
amendment at the meeting or an adjournment thereof.
