**REQUEST:** Administration request that Town Council proclaim and recognize Tuesday, March 19, 2024, as "Election Day" for the purpose of electing officials to Seats #4 and #5 of the Town Council.

**SUMMARY:** The Town of Eatonville will hold its general Town Election on Tuesday, March 19, 2024, during the Presidential Preference Primary election. Resolution 2023-26 was adopted on September 19, 2023, by the Town Council of the Town of Eatonville, Florida, authorizing The Town Council to change the regular general election on Saturday, March 2, 2024, to Tuesday, March 19, 2024, during the Presidential Preference Primary. Section 5.03 of the Town Charter provides that if a regular election occurs in the same month as a Presidential Preference Primary, the Town Council may choose to hold the Town election on the same date as the primary.

Voting shall take place between the hours of 7:00 a.m., and 7:00 p.m., on March 19, 2024, at the Town Hall, 307 East Kennedy Boulevard, Eatonville, Florida.

The Orange County Supervisor of Elections and staff shall be in charge of conducting the Election in accordance with the Election laws of the State of Florida, and also serve as the Appointed Election Board.

The qualifying period for the Town's March 2024 general election was held at noon November 10, 2023, and closed at noon November 17, 2023.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Administration recommends that Town Council proclaim and recognize Tuesday, March 19, 2024, as "Election Day" for the purpose of electing officials to Seats #4 and #5 of the Town Council.
