In honor of the former and deceased Mayor Bruce Mount and his wife Winnie Mount, the Bruce and Winnie Mount Scholarship Program has been established to encourage and support new high school graduates, 1st year College Student (Freshman), and 2nd Year College Student (Sophomore) as they enter into the next phase of their academic experience beyond high school. Application opened and has been available since April 13, 2026, The deadline to submit all completed applications ended on July 31, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. After July 31, 2026, the reviewing committee will convene and begin the necessary steps towards identifying eligible applicants for recommendations.

The Bruce and Winnie Mount Scholarship Reviewing Committee will be responsible for reviewing all applications received on or before the application deadline ensuring that all scholarship guidelines for eligibility have been met by each applicant. Upon review, the reviewing committee will compile all findings and submit final recommendations for eligible recipient(s) of the Bruce and Winnie Mount Scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be a resident of the Town of Eatonville
2. Must be a current Senior in High School or an active College Student within 2 years of High School graduation.
3. Minimum un-weighted Grade Point Average of 2.5
(Official Transcript or Proof of Graduation Required)
4. Have Graduated or graduating within twelve (12) months of the scholarship date.
5. Acceptance to an accredited trade/technical school; two (2) or four (4) year College or University (Confirmation Letter Required).
6. Complete an essay (Minimum 200 words).
7. Complete 30 hours of Community Service at a Non-Profit Organization in Eatonville (A completed Community Service Log Form Required) ***Community Outside of Eatonville may be waived.*
