REQUEST: Staff request for the town council to hear a presentation to review and discuss the Water and Sewer Impact Fee Study.

SUMMARY: The Water and Sewer Impact Fee Study was prepared by the Florida Rural Water Association and is a membership benefit. Capacity fees or connection charges, are one-time charges assessed to new commercial and residential connections to reimburse utility systems for required infrastructure needed to maintain the utility system.
