<u>REQUEST</u>: Requesting for the elected officials and the Eatonville Community to be advised of the plans and cost beforehand of the celebration of our town's birthday.

SUMMARY: The Historic Town of Eatonville, the oldest Black Township Municipality Incorporated in the United States, will be celebrating its 137 years of freedom while bracing its legacy from the founders of enslaved citizens established in August 1887. The Historic Town of Eatonville, the town that freedom built will be celebrating 137 years in August 2024. The Eatonville Community has not been provided information about the historical event to the leadership after several inquiries. A response from the leadership, "I will let you know." The Eatonville Community deserves to be aware that this is the town's event for the people and inclusive for all not otherwise.
