REQUEST: Request for the Town Council to approve Resolution 2024-27 Health Services Provided By Grace Medical Home and the Central Florida Black Nurses Association of Orlando (CFBNA) in Partnership with the Town.

SUMMARY: The Black Nurses and Stephanie Garris, CEO, Grace Medical Health is seeking a collaboration with the Town of Eatonville to serve the community health education, screening and patient care services in the Eatonville Community to those who need it most. The Black Nurses have a history of health-related activities in the town and worked diligently at the former Healthy Eatonville. This is a great opportunity for a healthier community serving those with no insurance and no medical coverage focused on families, youth, homelessness, disadvantage, and behavioral life changes. A zoom meeting was held on August 15, 2024, with CAO Pressley and Councilwoman Randolph to discuss collaboration efforts.

Grace Medical Home staff and Recreation Director Washington were introduced and performed a walkthrough of the Denton Johnson Center to access the location and space. Grace Medical mobile unit will remain on site for one week every other month with the first month in November, then starting again in January or February 2025. These services will be scheduled up to six (6) one week service blocks for one year ending September 2025.

Additionally, October is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month to promote awareness and education to be proactive about overall health to decrease risk of developing breast cancer and other cancers for women and men. Early Detections. Promoting nutritional health.
