

RESOLUTION #2026-11 AMENDED

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING TERM LIMITS FOR THE NEWLY APPOINTED BOARD MEMBERS; TWO (2) INDIVIDUALS TO THE PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD AS A REGULAR BOARD MEMBER, AND TWO (2) INDIVIDUALS AS AN ALTERNATE BOARD MEMBER, ALL FOR A THREE (3) YEAR TERM PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS on Tuesday, March 17, 2026 two (2) individuals were appointed to the planning and zoning board as a regular board member, and two (2) individuals appointed as an alternate board member; and

WHEREAS the administration wishes to establish terms limits for the stated newly appointed regular board members and the newly appointed alternate board members.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: TERMS The two regular board members Tanecia Brooks and Lisa Grant and the two alternate board members Trevor L. Cobb (Alternate #1) and Jeffery Pearsall (Alternate #2) who were appointed to the planning and zoning board on Tuesday, March 17, 2026, will serve t on the planning and zoning board for a three year term from March 17, 2026 – March 17, 2029.

SECTION TWO: CONFLICTS: All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any other Resolution or any of the provisions of the Resolution is hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: SEVERABILITY: If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution is found to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section or part of this Resolution two

SECTION FOUR: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution will take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
