

RESOLUTION #2026-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, FLORIDA, Amending RESOLUTION 2026-15 THE SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS FOR CHECKS ISSUED BY THE TOWN AS A RESULT OF THE MARCH 7, 2026, GENERAL ELECTION TO INCLUDE THE NEWLY APPOINTMENT OF SEAT #5 ON MARCH 31, 2026, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to have the Town bank accounts be maintained in an orderly fashion and that checks be processed and issued in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the March 7, 2026, General Election for Town Council Seats #1, #2, and #3, three (3) new persons were elected, one (1) was not re-elected, to the Town Council; and one (1) current council member not elected as a running candidate vacating their current seat by way of an irrevocable resignation dated 3-16-2026.

WHEREAS, the Town Council appointed Wanda Randolph to vacant Seat #5 on March 31, 2026, with 30 days of the date of vacancy per the requirements of the Town’s Chapter.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, FLORIDA THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION ONE: The Town Council of the Town of Eatonville designates those two (2) signatures required on checks issued by the Town, and that **RUTHI CRITTON, ANGELA THOMAS, LADWYANA JORDAN and WANDA RANDOLPH** be added, and **THEO WASHINGTON** be removed as a check signatory; as an authorized check signer for the Town of Eatonville.

SECTION TWO: The Town Council of the Town of Eatonville designates that any two (2) members of the Town Council are authorized to sign checks for the Town of Eatonville.

SECTION THREE: The designated Town Council members as check signers are as follows:

- RUTHI CRITTON - MAYOR
- ANGELA THOMAS - COUNCILWOMAN
- LADWYANA JORDAN - COUNCILWOMAN
- TARUS MACK- COUNCILMAN
- WANDA RANDOLPH - COUNCILWOMAN

SECTION FOUR: CONFLICTS: All Resolution or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any other Resolution or any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE: SEVERABILITY: If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution is found to be invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION SIX: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
