

**RESOLUTION #2026-23**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, FLORIDA, DISSOLVING THE ELECTION CANVASSING BOARD FOLLOWING THE MARCH 7, 2026, GENERAL ELECTION PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS** the Town of Eatonville held its general election on Saturday March 7, 2026, for Town for Council Seats: 1, 2, and 3; and

**WHEREAS** the Town Council of the Town of Eatonville appointed two (2) citizens to the Canvassing Board for the March 7, 2026, General Election; and

**WHEREAS** the Town Council desire to dissolve the current Election Canvass Board post the 2026 town election and certification of the election results.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, FLORIDA THE FOLLOWING:**

**SECTION ONE:** the Town Council of the Town of Eatonville by adoption of this resolution has dissolved the Canvassing Board which consisted of Veronica King, the town clerk and (2) two appointed citizens Stephanie Goynes and Lisa Grant for the past 2026 Town Election held March 7, 2026.

**SECTION TWO: CONFLICTS:** All Resolution or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any other Resolution or any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

**SECTION THREE: SEVERABILITY:** If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution is found to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section or part of this Resolution.

**SECTION FOUR: EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
