SUMMARY: Ordinance #2023-6 Is An Ordinance of The Town of Eatonville, Florida, Establishing A Temporary Moratorium On The Issuance of New Building Permits For New Multi-Family, Mixed Use, Commercial or Single Family Residential For A Maximum of Three Hundred Sixty-Five (365) Days or 90 Days After The Adoption of An Impact Fee Ordinance, Which Ever Is Earlier.

Ordinance \$2023-6 was approved and passed upon the second reading on the 2 day of May, 2023.
