REQUEST: It is requested that the council review and discuss the proposed maps to provide input to the county regarding a best fit for the town.

SUMMARY:

In November 2024, Orange County voters approved a charter amendment to expand the number of commission districts from six to eight. To implement this change, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners will undertake a redistricting process to establish new district boundaries and incorporate the two additional districts. To support this effort, the Board formed the 2025 Mid-Decennial Redistricting Advisory Committee in January 2025. The committee is responsible for:

- Holding public meetings to gather community input
- Reviewing census data
- Proposing the boundaries for two new commission districts and recommending adjustments to existing districts
- Submitting a non-binding recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners for review in September 2025

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the council review and discuss the proposed maps to provide input to the county regarding a best fit for the town.
