AN ORDINANCE OF THE EDEN CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING KELLY STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE

	KELLY Street, fromBRYANtoTILLMAN Street is presently a two way street; and	
WHEREAS,	city staff along with consultation with their engineer have determined that _KELLY street would be safer for passage in one directions; and	
WHEREAS,	given the available streets, it is in the best interest of public safety to make <u>KELLY</u> Street a one-way street travelling from <u>BRYAN</u> to <u>TILLMAN</u> ; and	
	pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.001, the City has general authority to adopt an ordinance or police regulation that is for the good of the government, peace or order of the City and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the City.	
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Eden:		

- 1. A one-way street is hereby created on <u>KELLY</u> Street from <u>BRYAN</u> to <u>TILLMAN</u> within the City of Eden:
- 2. The City's Public Works Manager is hereby authorized to designate <u>KELLY</u> <u>Street</u> as a one-way street in accordance with this Ordinance, and is further directed to erect appropriate signs or other markings giving notice thereof:
- 3. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in any amount not exceeding \$200.
- 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon ten (10) days following its approval and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation.
- 5. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portion of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.
