Subject: Approval of Georgia Power Utility Relocation Agreement – Old Augusta Road & Logistic Parkway Roundabout

Item Description: Consideration to approve the Georgia Power Utility Relocation Agreement for work at the Old Augusta Road & Logistic Parkway Roundabout.

Summary Recommendation: Staff recommends approval of the Georgia Power Utility Relocation Agreement to authorize the relocation of existing utility facilities necessary for construction of the Old Augusta Road & Logistic Parkway Roundabout.

Executive Summary / Background:

Georgia Power submitted a Utility Relocation Agreement for relocating existing electrical facilities that conflict with the construction of the Old Augusta Road & Logistic Parkway Roundabout. The adjustments will remove conflicts between existing utility infrastructure and the proposed roadway improvements, allowing construction to proceed as designed while maintaining reliable electric service within the project corridor.

Under the agreement, the County will reimburse Georgia Power for eligible relocation costs associated with facilities for which Georgia Power has established compensable property rights. Georgia Power has identified compensable prior rights for the affected facilities and has provided an estimated relocation cost of \$143,919.

Approval of the agreement will authorize Georgia Power to proceed with the necessary utility adjustments and support the timely delivery of the roadway project.
