Subject: EOM Master Services Agreement Amendment 6 for FY26

Meeting Date: June 16, 2026

Item Description: Consideration to approve Amendment No. 6 to the Master Services Agreement for Professional Services with EOM Operations to renew the agreement for an additional term.

Summary Recommendation: Staff recommends approval of Amendment No. 6 to the Master Agreement for Professional Services with EOM Operations.

Executive Summary/Background:

Since 2018, the County has engaged EOM Operations for professional engineering services related to Public Works projects. The original Master Agreement was executed on September 15, 2020, and has been renewed annually to maintain service continuity.

Amendment No. 6 renews the Master Agreement for Professional Services for an additional one-year term beginning July 1, 2026 and terminating June 30, 2027. The amendment also provides that, in the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the original agreement and the amendment, the amendment shall control.

Approval of Amendment No. 6 will allow the County to continue utilizing EOM Operations for professional services under the established Master Agreement and approved task order process.

All services provided under this agreement will be detailed in Task Orders reviewed and approved by the Board.

Alternatives for Commission to Consider

1. Approve Amendment #6 of the Master Services Agreement for Engineering Professional Services with EOM Operations for FY 2027.
Reject the renewal and direct staff to initiate procurement for a new engineering services provider.
