Item Description: Change Order with Legacy Water Group for the Loop B Construction Project

Summary Recommendation: Staff recommends Approval of Change Order with Legacy Water

Group for the Loop B Construction Project

Executive Summary/Background:

 Effingham County entered into a contract with Legacy Water Group in June of 2023 for the construction of the Blue Jay Road Water/Reuse Line Extension Loop B (partially grant funded).

- Change Order 1 contained two requests: Request 1 states that due to a modification in
 the scope, there is a need for an additional 8 LF of 16" reuse water main, replacing a
 proposed 16" sleeve with a 20"x16" reducer for connection to the existing reuse water
 force main, and installation of a 2" air release valve connection point. The cost for this is
 \$10,129.00. Request 2 includes installation of 430 LF of 18" HDPE reuse main carrier
 pipe in a 24" casing under the Midland/Blue Jay intersection. The cost for this is
 \$192,388.00.
- Change Order 2 was for a time extension request, but this has not been submitted for approval by the BOC. Instead, the time extension was added with Change Order 3.
 There is also an increase due to the addition/installation of two (2) 16' gate valves near Marlow Elementary School. Staff requested approval from the County Manager because the construction was ending and didn't want to have the contractor re-mobilize.
- These requests have been reviewed and approved by Hussey, Gay, and Bell (the engineers on the project) and staff and T&H personnel recommend approval.

Alternatives for Commission to Consider

- 1. Approval of Change Order with Legacy Water Group for the Loop B Construction Project in the amount of \$33,382.00 and a time extension of 30 days.
- 2. Take no action.
