Summary Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval to expand the existing access control and security camera system at the Effingham County Administration Building to accommodate facility growth and enhance overall security. This project includes increasing access control points, adding security cameras, and upgrading system software for improved functionality and future scalability.

Executive Summary/Background:

The Effingham County Administration Building currently utilizes an access control system for 13 building doors. Due to recent facility expansion and renovations, the county seeks to enhance security by adding 12 new access control points and 18 security cameras. Additionally, the system's software will be upgraded to improve performance, accommodate future growth, and enable centralized management of multiple sites. This investment will significantly strengthen security measures and protect county assets.
