Summary Recommendation: Approval of implementation of the SS4A Action Plan via application for federal funding for an initial demonstration project as well as a more in-depth look at bicycle and pedestrian issues in the County.

Executive Summary/Background:

The Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grant Program offers the possibility of getting significant funding from the federal government through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) to hire a firm to develop a more comprehensive, wholistic Active Transportation Plan for the County.

The plan incorporates:

- Community and Stakeholder Input
- Assessment of Existing Conditions
- Identification of the High Injury Network (HIN)
- Solutions for the High Injury Network
- Recommended Policies and Programs
- Initial Demonstration project

The resultant plan analyzed crash data between 2019 and 2023 to identify safety needs. The plan identified high-risk crash locations, factors contributing to crashes, and prioritized strategies and projects to address identified safety concerns.
