## Summary Recommendation:

This will clarify the language in the ordinance to make it to where trucks must take the shortest distance to an existing truck route to get to their destination as intended in the original ordinance.

The sign used to identify truck routes is being updated to better communicate to truck drivers that certain roads are not identified on the Freight Route list.

## **Executive Summary/Background:**

Revise Chapter 74-8 (d) (6)

Drivers of commercial vehicles classified as Class 6 through 13, as defined in Sections 74-8(a) and (b), are required to travel exclusively on designated truck routes. When accessing a location off the truck route, drivers must use the shortest and most direct route to and from the nearest designated truck route of their origin or destination. Enforcement of this requirement shall be carried out by the officials designated in Section 74-8(e).

Revise Chapter 74-8 (f) (1) & Figure 2 Update Freight Route list and Figure to include:

- Blue Jay Rd
- McCall Road from Gateway Parkway to Hwy 21(Rincon)
- McCall Road from Hwy 21 Springfield to Blue Jay Rd
- Rahn Station Road
- Sandhill Rd from Blue Jay Rd to Hwy 80
