Item Description: Consideration to approve a professional services agreement with Goodwyn Mills Cawood, LLC (GMC) to perform pre-design services for the proposed renovation of the County office building located at 768 Hwy 119 in Guyton, Georgia.

Summary Recommendation: Staff recommends approval of the professional services proposal submitted by GMC in the amount of \$80,000 (plus reimbursables) to conduct facility condition assessment, space planning, cost estimating, and feasibility analysis for the renovation project.

Executive Summary/Background:

Effingham County is seeking to renovate its office facility adjacent to the Recreation Complex in Guyton, GA. As an initial step, the County has requested a comprehensive pre-design analysis to determine the scope and feasibility of renovation, potential additions, or reconfigurations to the existing building.

Goodwyn Mills Cawood, LLC (GMC) has submitted a detailed proposal outlining the scope of professional services, including:

- Facility condition assessment (structural, MEP, finishes, fire/life safety, ADA compliance)
- Space planning and conceptual design (up to 3 options)
- High-level cost estimating
- Site feasibility analysis and conceptual site plans
- Field measurement and as-built documentation
- Optional renderings

GMC proposes to complete the work within 8 weeks from notice to proceed.

The base proposal includes \$80,000 in professional services fees, plus reimbursable expenses not to exceed 10% of the total. Services will be billed monthly based on progress.
