AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE EFFINGHAM COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE, MAP AND PARCEL NO.
392-7A

AND TO REPEAL ALL OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Effingham County Board of Commissioners in regular meeting assembled and pursuant to lawful authority thereof:

WHEREAS, BARBARA JEAN ALDAY has filed an application for a conditional use to allow for a Rural Business in AR-1; map and parcel number 392-7A, located in the 4th commissioner district, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on March 3, 2026, and notice of said hearing having been published in the Effingham County Herald on February 11, 2026; and

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED THAT a conditional use to allow for a Rural Business in AR-1; map and parcel number 392-7A, located in the 4th commissioner district, is approved, with the following stipulations:

- 1. The applicant shall obtain, and keep in good standing, an Effingham County Occupational Tax Certificate (business license).**
- 2. Any new encroachments onto Little McCall Road must be approved by the county engineer.**
- 3. Hours of operation are limited to four days a week, 10 a.m.- 7 pm. No operations on Sundays.**
- 4. One non-illuminated temporary sign may be allowed during the specified business hours.**

All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
