Executive Summary:.

Dr. Henry Young is a native of Effingham County, born April 21, 1949. This resolution represents the Board's recognition of Dr. Young as the first black doctor from Effingham County and his 45-year achievement as a doctor.

Background:

- 1. Dr. Young grew up in Effingham County and is a graduate of Central High School.
- 2. To pay for college he joined the United States Air Force, working his way up to sergeant while serving in the Philippines and the Vietnam War.
- 3. Young also completed almost two years are college while enlisted in the armed services.
- 4. He is currently a practicing family physician in Cordele, Georgia .
