2. The determination of water consumption for the purpose of determining the number of equivalent residential units shall be based on the Water Use Standards contained below.

Sewer Connection Fee

1. A Sewer Development Fee of ~~\$7,423~~\$8,165 per residential unit, or equivalent residential unit, or any fraction thereof shall be paid prior to connection of any service line to the County's sewer system
2. The determination of water consumption for the purpose of determining the number of equivalent residential units shall be based on the Water Use Standards contained below.

Reuse Connection Fee

1. A Reuse Capital Cost Recovery Fee of ~~\$1,430~~\$1,573 per residential unit, or equivalent residential unit, or any fraction thereof shall be paid prior to connection of any service line to the County's reuse water system

The determination of water consumption for the purpose of determining the number of equivalent residential units shall be based on the Water Use Standards contained below.
