A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF EFFINGHAM COUNTY, GEORGIA REGARDING DUE DATE FOR PROPERTY TAXES

WHEREAS, the current due date for payment of ad valorem real property taxes due to Effingham County, Georgia is November 20th of each tax year; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Commissioner of Effingham County has requested that the due date for ad valorem real property taxes due Effingham County, Georgia be kept the same on November 20th of each tax year starting with the 2025 tax year; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Effingham County, Georgia (hereinafter referred to as "Board of Commissioners") agrees that the tax due date should not be changed from November 20th to assist with cash flow and budgeting for Effingham County; and

WHEREAS, Georgia law allows the due date to be November 20th and nothing in O.C.G.A. §48-5-24 requires Effingham County to change the due date; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same, as follows: That the due date for payment of ad valorem real property taxes be November 20th beginning with tax year 2025 and continuing year after year unless and until such due date is changed by any subsequent resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all previous Resolutions of the Board of Commissioners in conflict herewith are hereby superseded and repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective upon

adoption. It shall remain in full force and effect until superseded or repealed.
