Item Description: Consideration to approve project cost for relocating a 4-inch high-pressure (HP) steel gas main at Blue Jay Rd and Midland.

Summary Recommendation: Staff recommends approval of the estimated budget for the relocation of the gas main and authorization to proceed with procurement and execution of the work.

Executive Summary/Background:

The City of Claxton has provided a cost estimate for the relocation of the existing 4-inch HP steel gas main at Blue Jay Rd and Midland. The project involves installing a new gas main using horizontal directional drilling (HDD) within the back 2 feet of the right-of-way (RW) at a depth of 6 feet to clear construction conflicts.

The total estimated cost for the project is \$111,720, which includes:

- Material and Labor: \$95,000
- Contingencies (5%): \$4,750
- Engineering & Other Costs: \$11,970

This project is critical to ensure that gas utility services are not disrupted by ongoing or future construction activities.

Alternatives for Commissioners to Consider

- 1. Approve the proposed cost estimate and proceed with project execution.
- 2. Do not approve the cost estimate and delay relocation, which may result in construction conflicts and service disruptions.
- 3. Provide alternative directions to staff
