**Summary Recommendation:** Staff recommends approving a purchase agreement with Ten-8 Fire and Safety for two Fire engines

## **Executive Summary/Background:**

Effingham County Fire Rescue (ECFR) currently operates 17 front line fire engines, along with 4 spare Engines, 8 Tankers, and 1 Ladder Truck.

In keeping up with a standard replacement program, and to avoid large quantity purchases, staff recommend ordering two fire engines this year. The current delivery time is approximately 32-36 months for Engines. These Fire Engines will replace two that will be over 25 years old upon delivery.

Due to extended delivery times, these apparatus will not be received/paid for until FY 2029.
