AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE EFFINGHAM COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE, MAP AND PARCEL NO. 460-48

## AND TO REPEAL ALL OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Effingham County Board of Commissioners in regular meeting assembled and pursuant to lawful authority thereof:

WHEREAS DENNIS TROTTER AS AGENT FOR KRISTA SECKINGER has filed an application to rezone two (2) +/acres; from AR-1 to B-2 to allow for the future development of a Dollar general store; map and parcel number 460-48, located in the 4th commissioner district, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on April 5, 2022 and notice of said hearing having been published in the Effingham County Herald on March 9, 2022; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Effingham County Planning Board, notice of said hearing having been published in the Effingham County Herald on March 2, 2022; and

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED THAT two (2) +/- acres; map and parcel number 460-48, located in the 4th commissioner district is rezoned from AR-1 to B-2, with the following conditions:

1. Minor subdivision plat must be recorded before the rezoning can take effect.

- 2. The lot shall meet the requirements of the B-2 zoning district.
- 3. A Sketch Plan must be approved by the Board of Commissioners before site development plans are submitted.
- 4. Site development plans shall comply with the Effingham County Water Resources Protection Ordinance and the Stormwater Management Local Design Manual.
- 5. All wetland impacts must be approved and permitted by USACE.
- 6. A traffic study must be submitted during the development plan review process, pursuant to Effingham County Traffic Study Requirements.

All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
