Item Description: Consideration to approve an amendment to the FY27 budget.

Summary Recommendation:

Staff is requesting approval of an amendment to the FY27 budget.

Executive Summary:

Each year the Board of Commissioners proposes a tentative budget. During the year, the Board receives requests from agencies and department heads to adjust the budget. Additionally, other factors, such as revenue, may fluctuate thereby allowing the Board to direct that additional expenditures be made. Therefore, a formal budget resolution incorporating these factors is made to adjust the budget accordingly. a

Background:

Georgia Law 6-81-3. Requires the establishment of fiscal year; requirement of annual balanced budget; adoption of budget ordinances or resolutions generally; budget amendments; uniform chart of accounts. Section (b)(1) notes that each unit of local government shall adopt and operate under an annual balanced budget for the general fund, each special revenue fund, and each debt service fund in use by the local government. The annual balanced budget shall be adopted by ordinance or resolution and administered in accordance with this article.

The budget amendment attached reflects the following changes:

1. One part-time position in the Clerk of Courts' Office should have been budgeted as a full-time, this amendment corrects that.
2. Security upgrades originally planned for FY26 will be happening in FY27, and so this amendment carries those forward. These upgrades are for fire stations, EMS, the MACC building, and the solid waste collection site.

Alternatives for Commission to Consider:

1. Approve the resolution to amend the budget for FY27.
2. Do not approve the resolution.
3. Provide staff with direction.

Recommended Alternative:

Staff recommends Alternative number 1 – Approve the resolution to amend the budget for FY27.
