**Summary Recommendation:** Staff recommends approval of GDOT LAP Application to be competitive to receive federal funding for future road projects.

**Executive Summary/Background:** The Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) has developed a Local Administered Projects (LAP) Certification process to ensure the resource capacity and ability of the Local Public Agency (LPA) to successfully manage, administer and execute the policies and procedures for Federal and State compliance in order to receive federal funding participation.

The LAP Certification application will be used to determine if Local Public Agencies will qualify to administer federal-aid projects. The GDOT serves as the prime recipient of federal transportation funds. In accordance with 23 Code of Federal Regulation Part 635.105, GDOT is the supervising agency; as such, it is responsible for authorizing performance of the work by the Local Agency on all Federal-aid projects.
