Subject: Discussion of Potential Road Resurfacing Projects for Upcoming LRA Grant Funding

Item Description: Discussion of potential road resurfacing projects for future LRA grant funding opportunities.

Executive Summary/Background

This work session is to review and discuss a preliminary list of roadway resurfacing and paving projects for consideration in the upcoming Local Road Assistance (LRA) grant funding opportunities.

The purpose of the discussion is to:

- Review of current roadway conditions throughout the County
- Identify roads requiring resurfacing, rehabilitation, or other roadway improvements
- Discuss project prioritization based on roadway condition, traffic volumes, safety concerns, and long-term infrastructure planning

Based on current estimates, approximately \$1.4 million in LRA funding could resurface an estimated 6.75 miles of roadway. The proposed roadway list is preliminary and intended to facilitate discussion regarding future transportation funding priorities and capital improvement planning.

Input received during the work session will assist Engineering staff in refining project recommendations and preparing future LRA grant applications and project considerations.
