Proposal

Summary Recommendation: Staff recommends approval of the OpenGov Capital Budgeting Proposal to enhance the county's capital budget management capabilities, streamline reporting processes, and improve transparency.

Executive Summary/Background:

Effingham County has received a proposal from OpenGov to implement a comprehensive capital budgeting system tailored to the county's needs. This system aims to modernize and improve efficiency in budget planning, capital project tracking, and financial reporting. Key deliverables include:

- Configuration of budget instances for up to 50 capital projects.
- Development of four budget publication templates.
- Training for administrative and end-users.
- Integration of financial data from ADG to OpenGov for accurate and real-time budget tracking.

The total cost for the proposal, spanning a 2.5-year subscription, is \$116,309.97. This includes software costs and professional services. Additionally, optional modules for operating budgets and workforce planning can be included for an annual cost of \$40,057.
