## **Executive Summary/Background**

- At the August 5, 2025, Board of Commissioners meeting, the Board approved the updated Commercial District (B-districts) ordinances.
- The proposed update is to remove the language that would require commercial development to provide a payment in lieu of sidewalk construction.
- Sidewalks will be a requirement as part of the Commercial Districts; however, if an applicant for commercial development did not want to provide the sidewalks, they would be able to come to the Board of Commissioners for a variance from the ordinance.
