**Item Description:** Consideration to approve an updated Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Effingham County and Hi-Lo SORBA, Inc., a chapter of the Southern Off-Road Bicycle

Association (SORBA), for volunteer support and cooperation in the development and

maintenance of natural-surface multi-use trails.

**Summary Recommendation:** Staff recommends the Board approve the revised MOU with Hi-Lo SORBA, Inc., replacing the prior version to reflect updated organizational information and continued partnership on trail initiatives.

## **Executive Summary / Background:**

Effingham County has partnered with the local SORBA chapter to support public access to safe, sustainable multi-use trails through volunteer construction and maintenance efforts. The updated Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) reflects the group's legal incorporation as Hi-Lo SORBA, Inc., with no change to the scope of collaboration or responsibilities. Under the agreement:

- The County will provide information on eligible trail locations and ensure alignment with park policies.
- Hi-Lo SORBA will supply volunteer labor and technical expertise for trail building and upkeep.
- All trail designs must follow IMBA guidelines and receive prior County approval.

This MOU is non-binding financially, may be terminated by either party with 60 days' notice, and complies with all applicable laws and non-discrimination requirements.
