### Summary Recommendation:

Staff request approval of the Proclamation recognizing Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA) week.

### Executive Summary:

The Board of Commissioners commonly supports initiatives which provide awareness of organizations and associations dedicated to encouraging positivity, leadership and community service and service excellence.

### Background:

The Future Business Leaders of America Inc. is a nonprofit organization. Hamden L. Forkner Sr. of Columbia University established its first chapter in 1942 in the state of Tennessee. The association is headquartered in Reston Virginia. This nonprofit organization consists of middle school, high school and college students, aiding in their development to transition into the business world.

There are approximately 250,000 members nationwide. Effingham County's chapter consists of roughly 48 members. Vice Chair Deloach will be presenting the proclamation to staff and student group at a school event on Friday, February 7<sup>th</sup>.
