25-1271	Missing Child	EPD received a call from a parent stating their teenage child was missing. Utilizing local resources, the child was found safe and returned to their parent.
25-1265	Motor Vehicle Crash	During a snowstorm, an EPD Officer responded to a crash where a vehicle had run off the road into a fence. The vehicle then left the scene. The Officer located the run driver, who was issued a summons for a traffic offense.
25-1089	Stalking	EPD responded to a report of alleged stalking. After investigation, there was insufficient probable cause to support criminal charges.
25-1376	Disorderly Conduct	EPD responded to a report of a heavily intoxicated party at a local business. The business was closed for the evening, and the subject had refused to remove themselves from the property. After investigation, it was determined several crimes had occurred. The suspect was arrested and booked into the Elbert County Jail.

25-1512	Traffic Complaint	EPD received a report from the Elizabeth School District Transportation about a vehicle that had failed to stop at the school bus stop sign. The driver who failed to stop was identified and issued a municipal summons for a traffic offense.
25-1524	Mental Health Hold	EPD responded to a local school on report of a juvenile who had suicidal ideations. The student was evaluated by school counselors and Centennial Mental Health. The student agreed to a voluntary mental health hold, and EPD transported the juvenile to a mental health facility.

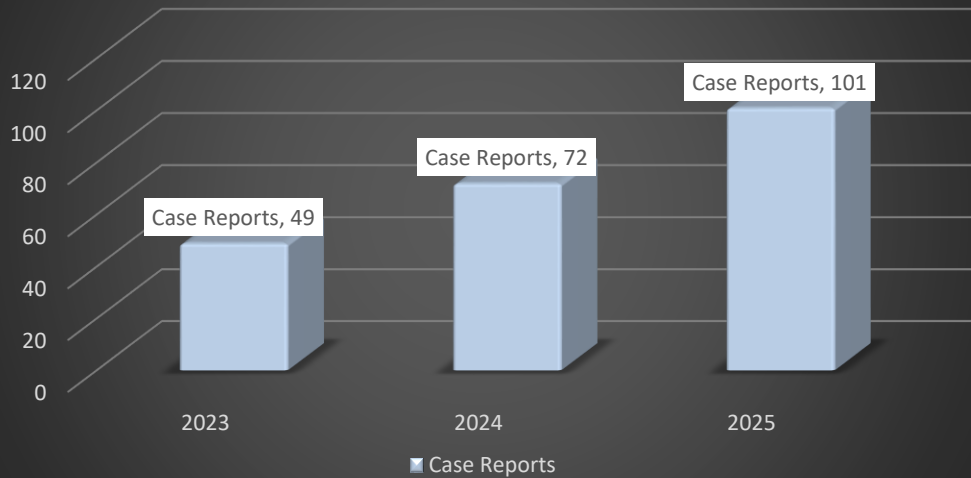
