Case/Incident Number:	Call Type:	Details:
25-0607	Mental Health Hold	EPD responded to a local school on a report that a student was suicidal. After evaluation from school counselors and Centennial Mental Health, the student was considered high risk. EPD transported the juvenile to a local mental health facility.
25-0616	Assist to Elbert County	While conducting a related investigation, disclosures were made involving a possible sex assault involving a juvenile. It was determined that the alleged crime would not have occurred in the Town of Elizabeth. The case was forwarded to the Elbert County Sheriff's Office for further investigation.
24-3188	Municipal Ordinance Violation	EPD's Community Services Division closed a long-standing case regarding accumulation of debris in Town. The property owner refused to come into compliance with the Town code and was therefore issued a municipal summons for several offenses.
25-0434	Motor Vehicle Accident	EPD responded to a single vehicle crash vs. a deer. Upon arrival, there were no injuries, and the deer did not need to be euthanized.
25-0499	Found Property	EPD had a wallet turned into the station. The owner was identified, and the wallet was returned to them.

25-0507	Motor Vehicle Accident	EPD responded to a report that a juvenile had struck a fire hydrant in the snow and left the scene. EPD located the juvenile and issued them a municipal summons for several traffic offenses.
25-0663	Informational Report	EPD took a report regarding a former employee.
25-0504	Theft	EPD responded to a report of three subjects who stole a large amount of merchandise from a local store. After investigation, the suspects were located and turned themselves in to EPD. They were issued municipal summonses for shoplifting.
25-0758	Motor Vehicle Accident	EPD responded to a two-vehicle crash. After investigation, the driver who violated the model traffic code was issued a municipal summons.
25-0767	Domestic Violence	EPD responded to a verbal domestic violence call. After investigation, it was determined that probable cause existed that the male subject had committed a crime. The male subject at that point became suicidal and was taken to a local mental health facility. A warrant was sought for their arrest upon release from the mental health facility.
25-0762	Theft	EPD received a report of a stolen license plate. After investigation, it was undetermined if in fact the plate was stolen and if it was, if the plate was stolen in the Town of Elizabeth. The license plate number was entered into NCIC/CCIC as stolen.

		investigation determined there was insufficient probable cause to proceed with criminal charges. The Elbert County Department of Human Services was notified.
25-0613	Assault	EPD responded to a local school on a reported assault. After investigation, it was determined that the juvenile would be best served by counseling and was turned over to the school district.
25-0788	Theft	EPD responded to a local business on a report of a theft in progress. EPD contacted the suspect as they were leaving the store. The property was recovered, and the suspect was issued a municipal summons for theft.
25-0825	Theft	Related to another investigation, EPD took a report of a theft. After investigation, it was determined there was insufficient probable cause to pursue criminal charges.
24-4865	Assault	EPD concluded an investigation where it was reported that an adult had assaulted a juvenile. After an extensive investigation, there was insufficient evidence to proceed with criminal charges.
25-0791	Domestic Violence	EPD responded to an address on report of an active disturbance involving two subjects. Upon arrival, both subjects had sustained injury. After investigation, it was discovered this was a domestic violence case. The primary aggressor was taken into custody and booked into the Elbert County Jail.
