## Background

As the City increases its efforts to obtain grants, it becomes more and more important that they are properly accounted for within the City's financial system. On January 2, 2025, the City Commission approved the establishment of a Grants Fund when the EDA Targeted Industry Grant was accepted.

The City has a need for two distinct grant funds. One will account for Governmental Funds grants and the other will account for account for Water and Sewer Utility Fund grants.

This budget amendment establishes a budget for City grants received thus far in FY 2024/25, excluding any of the Coolidge Street project grants. Because of the complexity of the Coolidge Street grants, those grants will remain within their respective funds.

### **Grant Overview**

In addition to the EDA grant, the City has been awarded two Edward Bryne / JAG grants for police equipment and an ARPA grant from Lake County for the Johnson's Point Septic to Sewer project.

# **Budget Impact Analysis**

These grants have no net change to the City's budget. They are all fully funded and do not require any City funds.

### Staff Recommendation

Staff is recommending approval of Resolution Number 25-22 amending the FY 2024/25 budgets for the Governmental Funds and Water and Sewer Utility grants funds.
