**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIR OAKS RANCH, TEXAS
AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE
CITY OF BOERNE AND KENDALL COUNTY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND UTILITIES
COMMUNICATION SERVICES, EXPENDITURE OF THE REQUIRED FUNDS, AND
EXECUTION OF ALL APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS BY THE CITY MANAGER.**

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act gives counties and cities the authority to contract with other governmental entities concerning police protection and other related services, and,

WHEREAS, the Parties desire that a centralized public safety and utilities communications office be provided, and,

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to form a Board of Directors to oversee the centralized public safety and utilities communications office, and,

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to share the costs and benefits of a centralized public safety and utilities communications office, and,

WHEREAS, the Parties find that their cooperation in the matters contained in this Agreement will increase the efficiency and effectiveness of these governmental functions and services and, by entering into this Agreement pursuant to the authority granted by Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code (the Interlocal Cooperation Act), will be a benefit to all citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIR OAKS RANCH, TEXAS:

- Section 1** The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with the City of Boerne and Kendall County for public safety and utilities communications services, to expend required funds up to \$317,736.43, and to execute any and all applicable documents to effectuate this resolution.
- Section 2.** That the recitals contained in the preamble hereto are hereby found to be true and such recitals are hereby made a part of this resolution for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the Council.
- Section3.** If any provision of this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this resolution and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the City Council hereby declares that this resolution would have been enacted without such invalid provision.
- Section 4.** That it is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this resolution is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this resolution, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code.

Section 5. All resolutions or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provision of this resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

Section 6. This resolution shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

Section 7. This resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its final passage, and it is so resolved.
