INTRODUCTION/BACKGROUND:

As a condition for issuing the City of Boerne a development permit for their proposed water plant, Kendall County required the dedication of a 14-foot right of way to the City of Fair Oaks Ranch for a property located at 329 Ammann Road. The 14-foot right-of-way dedication is located on the east side of a 10-acre tract west of Ammann Road (Exhibit A). The 10-acre tract is owned by the City of Boerne, next to and outside the City of Fair Oaks Ranch.

The 2019 Water, Wastewater and Reuse Master Plan requires an elevated storage tank (water tower) in the vicinity of the property under consideration. Public Works staff have indicated the property is the preferred location for an elevated storage tank. This right-of-way dedication to the City will be used to align the City's planned Ammann Road Reconstruction project with Kendall County's plans to widen the "90 degree turn" at the northern bounds of city limits and the Kendall County line.

POLICY ANALYSIS/BENEFIT(S) TO CITIZENS:

- 1. Texas Local Government Code § 232.001 Acceptance of Dedication requires home rule municipalities to accept right-of-way dedications for land located outside the city limits.
- 2. The City of Fair Oaks Ranch 2019 Water, Wastewater and Reuse Master Plan Capital Improvement Plan identifies the requirement for a new, elevated water storage tank to provide emergency and pressure equalization storage in pressure Zone A.
- 3. The proposed action aligns with priority 3.1 of the Strategic Action Plan Enhance and Ensure Continuity of Reliable Water Resources in Accordance with CCN Obligations
- 4. The proposed action aligns with priority 3.4 of the Strategic Action Plan Enhance & Ensure Continuity of Reliable Roadway Improvement Initiatives
