INTRODUCTION/BACKGROUND:

At the December 7, 2023, Council meeting, Mr. Rich Nichols requested consideration for additional stop signs at the intersections of Battle Intense/Hansel Drive/High Eschelon and Battle Intense/Venturer Lane/Keeneland Drive. He mentioned several near misses at these locations and believes the addition of stop signs will mitigate future incidents. Mr. Nichols made a similar request in October 2019. The City Council held a workshop on February 6, 2020. Traffic study efforts were halted when the COVID-19 pandemic caused significant changes in traffic patterns.

In January 2024, the City's General Engineering Consultant studied these intersections, including the capture of drone footage and traffic counts during peak morning and afternoon traffic. The purpose of this workshop is to present the traffic study results and to obtain Council guidance on which mitigation measures, if any, to implement. Should Council determine that additional stop signs are needed at these locations, staff will bring back an ordinance for consideration at a future meeting.
