AGENDA TOPIC: Update regarding UDC Policy Amendments

INTRODUCTION/BACKGROUND:

On September 7, 2023, City Council returned the Unified Development Code (UDC) to the Planning & Zoning Commission (P&Z) to rework the amendments by first addressing statutory and regulatory changes and prioritizing all proposed policy changes.

With statutory and regulatory changes on the path towards adoption, the P&Z held a workshop on December 14, 2023, to review the proposed UDC policy changes and grouped these policy changes into "categories." A total of sixteen (16) categories were identified. The top 10 categories were prioritized as follows with the remaining categories to be prioritized at a later date.

- 1. Subdivision Design (includes blocks, easements, streets)
- 2. Infrastructure (includes design and construction standards, stormwater, water quality protection, floodplain, fiscal surety, permits)
- 3. Drive Throughs
- 4. Parking Lots
- 5. Building Standards
- 6. Building Design
- 7. Landscaping
- 8. Hill Country Aesthetics
- 9. Mixed Use Village
- 10. Table 4.2 (Permitted Uses within each Zoning District)

Categories to be prioritized at a later date:

- Conservation Development Alternative (CDA)/Low Impact Development (LID)
- Setbacks
- Screening
- Trees
- Conditional Uses
- Signs

On January 11, 2024, the P&Z held a workshop on the top three prioritized categories: Subdivision Design, Infrastructure, and Drive Through. Staff will schedule a City Council workshop on these categories upon completion of the P&Z Commission's review.
