RECOMMENDED COUNCIL ACTION: Motion certify the abstract of returns from the City of Fallon Special Election held July 21, 2026.

DISCUSSION:

Pursuant to NRS 293C.387(2), after the City Council receives the returns from the Special Election from all the precincts and districts (wards) in the City, the City Council and the Mayor shall canvass the returns. The canvass must be completed on or before the 10th day following the election.

Pursuant to NRS 293C.387(3), in completing the canvass of the returns, the City Council and the Mayor shall:

- (a) Note separately any clerical errors discovered; and
- (b) Take account of the changes resulting from the discovery, so that the result declared represents the true vote cast.

Pursuant to NRS 293C.387(4), after the canvass is completed, the City Council and Mayor shall declare the result of the canvass. The City Clerk shall enter upon the records of the City Council an abstract of the results pursuant to NRS 293C.387(5).

Pursuant to NRS 293C.387(6), after the City Clerk enters an abstract of the results upon the records of the City Council, the City Council should, by motion, enter an Order causing the City Clerk to:

1. Certify the abstract;
2. Make a copy of the certified abstract;
3. Make a mechanized report of the abstract in compliance with regulations adopted by the Secretary of State;
4. Transmit a copy of the certified abstract and the mechanized report of the abstract to the Secretary of State on or before the 10th day following the election; and
5. Transmit on paper or by electronic means to each public library in the City, or post on a website maintained by the City or the City Clerk on the internet or its successor, if any, a copy of the certified abstract within thirty (30) days after the election.
