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1. PREAMBLE:

This Amendment 1 (Amendment) to Contract 07-SNR-01026 (Contract) is made this

between the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, DEPARTMENT OF

ENERGY, WESTERN AREA POWER ADMINISTRATION (WAPA) and the TRUCKEE

DONNER PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT, a Public Utility District, organized and existing

under the laws of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as Truckee; and the

22 State of Nevada, hereinafter referred to as Fallon; jointly referred to as TDF, their

CITY OF FALLON, a political subdivision organized and existing under the laws of the

23 successors and assigns; all also hereinafter referred to individually as Party and

together as Parties.

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2. EXPLANATORY RECITALS:

2.1. The United States owns, and the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) operates, the Stampede Powerplant (Stampede)

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located in Sierra County, California. Stampede has an installed capacity of 3.65 megawatts, with an average annual energy generation of approximately 11,000 megawatthours.

2.2. Truckee and Fallon have Network Integration Transmission Service Agreements (NITS) with SPPC and, therefore, can receive the Stampede Energy.

2.3. WAPA and TDF entered into the Contract on May 10, 2007. The Contract provides for TDF to take the generation available from Stampede into its system and, through an energy exchange account, serve two U.S. Department of the Interior, Department of Fish and Wildlife Service project use loads located within its service territory.

2.4. The Contract is scheduled to terminate on December 31, 2024. The Parties desire to extend the term through December 31, 2044.

2.5. The Parties agree the Value Calculation in Exhibit A should be updated to accurately value the Stampede generation and are doing so in this Amendment.

3. AGREEMENT:

The Parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth herein.

4. TERM OF AMENDMENT:

This Amendment shall become effective upon execution and shall remain in effect concurrently with the Contract.

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5. MODIFICATION OF SECTION 4 (EFFECTIVE DATE, TERM AND

TERMINATION OF CONTRACT) OF THE CONTRACT:

Section 4.1 of the Contract is hereby modified as follows:

4. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE, TERM, AND TERMINATION OF CONTRACT</u>:

4.1 This Contract will become effective on the first day of the first month following the termination of Contract 00010 with SPPC and shall remain in effect through December 31, 2044; subject to prior termination as otherwise provided for herein.

6. MODIFICATION OF SECTION 10 (VALUE CALCULATION) OF THE

CONTRACT:

Section 10 of the Contract is hereby modified as follows:

10. VALUE CALCULATION:

The calculation to be used in determining the value of Stampede Energy is provided in Exhibit A attached hereto.

7. EXECUTION BY COUNTERPARTS:

This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts and, upon execution and delivery by each Party, the executed and delivered counterparts together shall have the same force and effect as an original instrument as if all Parties had signed the same instrument. Any signature page of this Amendment may be detached by any counterpart of this Amendment without impairing the legal effect of any signatures thereon and may be attached to another counterpart of this Amendment identical in form hereto, by having attached to it one or more signature pages.
