POSSIBLE COUNCIL ACTION: Motion to approve and adopt Resolution 24-05: A resolution of the City Council of the City of Fallon regarding its intention to issue tax-exempt obligations and to reimburse the City from proceeds of such obligations for the costs incurred prior to issuance.

DISCUSSION: Ordinance 782 allows the City to issue revenue bonds to fund the procurement of sanitation trucks. Due to the critical need, resolution 24-05 will allow the City to recoup the acquisition costs of sanitation trucks incurred before the issuance of the obligations. The City is currently looking at two used sanitation trucks to purchase immediately and to order two additional new trucks which have a delivery time of over a year.
