
## Calls for Service / Total Incidents Reported








#### **BREAKDOWN OF ARRESTS**

During the month of April, the Police Department had thirty-one (31) total arrests:

- Of the four (4) felony arrests, all four (4) were P&P violations.
- There was one (1) gross misdemeanor arrest, which was a warrant arrest.
- Of the twelve (12) misdemeanor arrests, six (6) were misdemeanor warrant arrests.
- There were ten (10) juvenile arrests, two (2) felonies, one (1) gross misdemeanor and seven (7) misdemeanor.

The two (2) felony arrests were for being under the influence of drugs and terroristic threats.

The gross misdemeanor arrest was for battery of a peace officer.

The misdemeanor arrests break down as two (2) for disturbance of school, two (2) for minor in consumption of alcohol one (1) for domestic battery, one (1) for possession of marijuana, one (1) for battery and one (1) for child in need of supervision.
