DISCUSSION: Valeria Carreto-Zapata, General Manager of Fajitas Gourmet has made application for a drinking establishment (on-premise) liquor license and a retail establishment (off-premise) liquor license manager change for Fajitas Gourmet to be located at 125 S. Maine Street. A drinking establishment liquor license is a privileged license that allows the licensee to sell alcoholic beverages from a fixed and definite place of business for consumption upon the premises only. A retail liquor license is a privileged license that allows the licensee to sell alcoholic beverages from a fixed and definite place of business for consumption off of the premises only.

The application has been reviewed by Captain John Riley, Chief of Staff Robert Erickson, City Attorney Trent deBraga, City Engineer Derek Zimney, and Deputy City Clerk Elsie Lee and has been recommended for approval
