The College of the Florida Keys (the “College”) inclusive postsecondary education program, Project ACCESS (Accessing Community College Educational experiences, Social experiences and Skills for Careers) has served students with Intellectual Disabilities since 2013. The College received approval as a Florida Postsecondary Comprehensive Transition Program (FPCTP) in 2017 and received renewal approval in 2020. The College is re-applying for program renewal again in 2025. With the support of the Florida Center for Students with Unique Abilities grant, the program has improved outcomes and expanded opportunities for students.

Project ACCESS and the College’s designation as a FPCTP directly align with the mission, vision, and values of the College. As such, the District Board of Trustees of The College of the Florida Keys reaffirms its continuing commitment to the program.
