RULE NO: RULE TITLE 4.420: Tobacco Free Policy

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: This policy enables The College of the Florida Keys to fulfill its responsibility in providing a comfortable and healthy work environment for faculty, staff, students and visitors by reducing exposure to toxins in smoking and the use of tobacco products. This Policy is intended to comply with the Florida Clean Indoor Air Act and the Laws of Florida, Chapter 92-185.

SUMMARY: Smoking and tobacco use is prohibited on any College grounds and all facilities owned, leased or operated by The College of the Florida Keys.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS: No Statement of Estimated Regulatory Cost was prepared.
