CFK Academy Class of 2025 Inaugural Graduation

On May 29, 2025 CFK Academy celebrated the first graduation in the Tennessee Williams Theater. Ten graduates received diplomas while four also graduated with their associates degree and two graduates also received college industry certifications. Keynote speaker was former principal Dr. Wendy McPherson and teacher of the year was math and digital media teacher Mrs. Kelly Hughes.



Enrollment Update

CFK Academy concluded the year with 60 students for the 2024-2025 school year. The current student enrollment for 2025-2026 consists of 77 students: 24 freshmen, 29 sophomores, 21 juniors, and 3 seniors.

Spring Assessment Data

Students at CFK Academy had increased proficiency in all subjects from the 2023-2024 school year. The Academy also out performed the district and the state in all tested areas. The focus for next year is to maintain and continue to foster high levels of rigor and student outcomes. School grades will be released in June-July. Currently CFK Academy is projecting another A-rating as set for the 2024-2025 year in Rule 6A-1.09981, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) School and district accountability.

The school grading formula is comprised of the following student success measures:

- Achievement
- Learning Gains- (ELA & Math & lowest performing 25%)
- Graduation (Lagging 2024 Data)
- Acceleration

Cognia Accreditation Update

- Currently, CFK Academy is in the pre-candidacy phase of Cognia accreditation. Perception surveys were administered in May with 75% completion from teachers, 85% completion from students, underrepresented family results.
