**Item Name:** Appointments to fill vacancies for the Primary Representative to the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) and the Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC).

**Background:** Currently there are three vacancies for Flagler Beach Citizen Representatives on the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization (R2CTPO). 1 Alternate position on the Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) and 1 Primary and 1 Alternate position on the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC). Mr. Ed Fendley is the current Primary Citizen Representative to the CAC.

Mr. Paul Mykytka has applied for one of the positions. Mr. Mykytka and Mr. Fendley discussed the roles on the Committees and are suggesting Mr. Mykytka be appointed to the Primary CAC position since his background is in Traffic Engineering, and Mr. Fendley be appointed to the Primary position on the BPAC since his background is with pedestrian and bicycle safety.

Neither Mr. Mykytka nor Mr. Fendley regrettably are able to attend tonight's meeting, Both request the Commission appoint them as requested.
