10 11 12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section 2 of the Constitution of the State of Florida and Chapter 166 of the Florida Statutes provide that municipalities shall have the governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers to enable them to conduct municipal government, perform municipal functions, and render municipal services, and exercise any power for municipal purposes except when expressly prohibited by law; and		
16 17 18	<b>WHEREAS,</b> Florida Statute 316.006(2) provides that chartered municipalities have original jurisdiction over all streets and highways located within their boundaries except for state roads; and		
19 20 21 22	<b>WHEREAS,</b> Florida Statute 316.008(j) provides that the provisions of Chapter 316 shall not be deemed to prevent local authorities, with respect to streets and highways under their jurisdiction and within the reasonable exercise of police power, from altering or establishing speed limits within the provisions of Chapter 316; and		
23 24	<b>WHEREAS,</b> a speed study investigation was conducted and presented to the City Commission; and		
25 26	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the speed study investigation contained recommendation to support reduction of the speed limit on City roads to twenty miles per hour; and		
27 28 29	<b>WHEREAS</b> , after consideration of the speed study, receiving public comment, and discussion, the City Commission has determined it appropriate to reduce speed limits on City roads to twenty miles per hour; and		
30 31 32	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Commission finds the measures set forth in this Ordinance are appropriate and necessary to provide for the protection of public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City.		
33 34	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FLAGLER BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:		
35 36 37	<b>SECTION ONE.</b> The findings set forth in the recitals above are hereby adopted as legislative findings of the City Commission pertaining to this Ordinance.		
38 39 40 41 42	<b>SECTION TWO.</b> The City of Flagler Beach hereby establishes a speed limit of 20 miles per hour upon City roads. The City Manager or his designee is directed to comply with the requirements for posting of speed limit signs as specified in Florida Statute 316.189(3). The posting of such signs is a prerequisite to the change of speed limits and enforcement of the reduced speeds, as set forth in Florida Statute 316.189(3).

49 50	<b>SECTION FIVE. Effective date.</b> This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption as provided by the Charter of the City of Flagler Beach.
